What's new !

1. RS Vorsfelde gets a new school building .



After the Easter Holidays all sixteen classes moved into the new building. The old parts will be restored and will become rooms for the grammar school.



In one and a half year all students from Kreuzheide will move to Vorsfelde. And then we will be 2000 students all together. We think the new building is good because everything is new, modern and colourful. While the building is being built there is a lot of noise which is disturbing lessons. What we normally have

1. There are optional courses in year 7: Spanish, art, politics, Woodwork fabrics and design, geography.

2. Our project groups are: CLHS, handball, volleyball, football, playing the guitar, judo, paramedical treatment – they take place in the afternoons.

What's special

Year 7: Many students took part in the "Future Day", we learned about different jobs, the girls learned about typical men's jobs, for example painters, mechanics, electricians, engineers. The boys got information about typical women's jobs, for example teacher for food technology, kindergarten nurse, nail studio, secretary. Sometimes it was cool, sometimes it was boring and exhausting.

There are sports competitions for years 5-10, year 7 and 8 play hockey and football, year 5 and 6 Brenball, year 9 and 10 usually play volleyball.

We have competitions for sports awards: swimming, athletics.

Year 10: There are final jokes and parties at the end of the school year and a big celebration when they get their reports.

There is a "Schnuppertag" for students of the primary schools who will attend our school next academic year: they have lessons in new subjects like English, French, Spanish, geography and science.
